METRO 2A-7 LIKELY TO RUN FROM MARCH

200 TRIPS PER DAY PLANNED, FARES ₹10-40

The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has drawn up plans to run around 200 services on the Phase I of the Metro 2A and 7 corridors in the western suburbs. Commissioning is expected in March, reports **Manthan K Mehta**

RAKES
● 10 received
● 8 will be deployed each day
● 2,280 passengers can travel on each six-coach Metro rake
